

Mystery Quilt Part 6: Corner Units



<p>Background Fabric Cut 8 strips 4 ½" x WOF</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Strips 1 & 2: sub-cut each strip into two 18 ½" x 4 ½" and one 4 ½" x 4 ½" • Strips 3 & 4: sub-cut each strip into two 14 ½" x 4 ½" and one 10 ½" x 4 ½" • Strip 5: sub-cut into three 12 ½" x 4 ½" and one 4 ½" x 4 ½" • Strip 6: sub-cut into one 12 ½" x 4 ½" and two 10 ½" x 4 ½" and one 6 ½" x 4 ½" • Strip 7: sub-cut into four 8 ½" x 4 ½" and one 6 ½" x 4 ½" • Strip 8: sub-cut into two 6 ½" x 4 ½" and one 4 ½" x 4 ½" 	<p>(No Main Fabric)</p>
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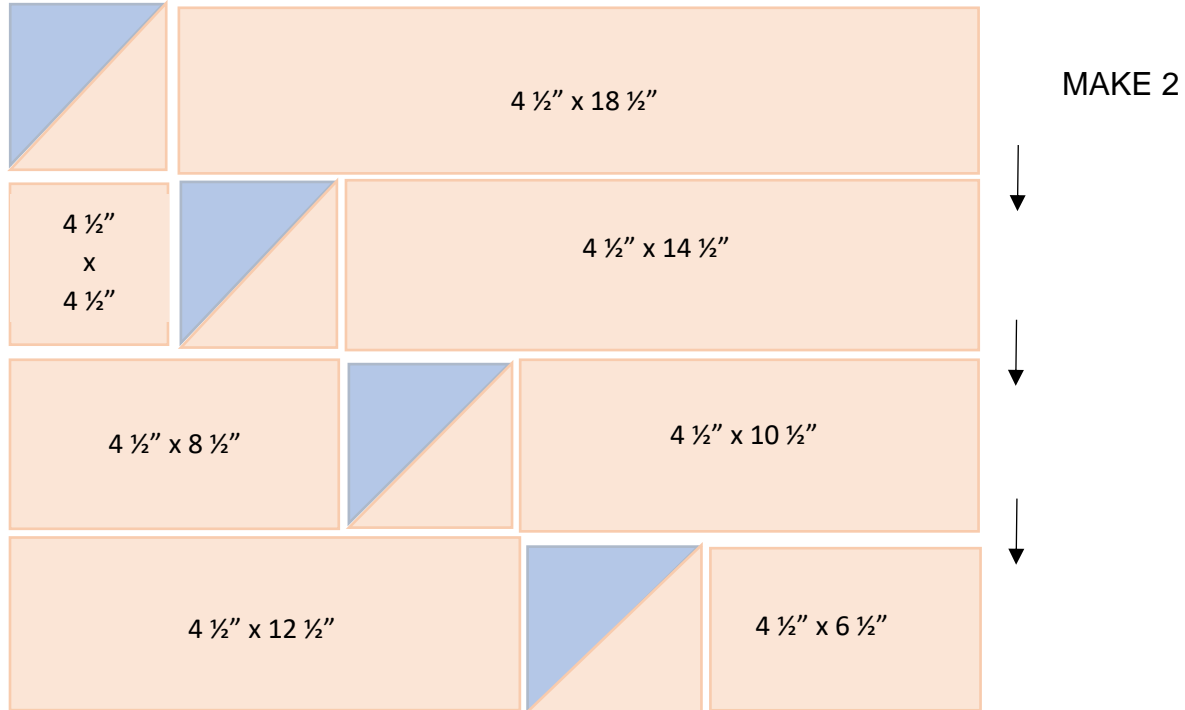
You will also need sixteen of the 4 ½" half square triangles from part 2 and two Wild Turkey Chase Variation Blocks

Layout pieces as shown in illustration.

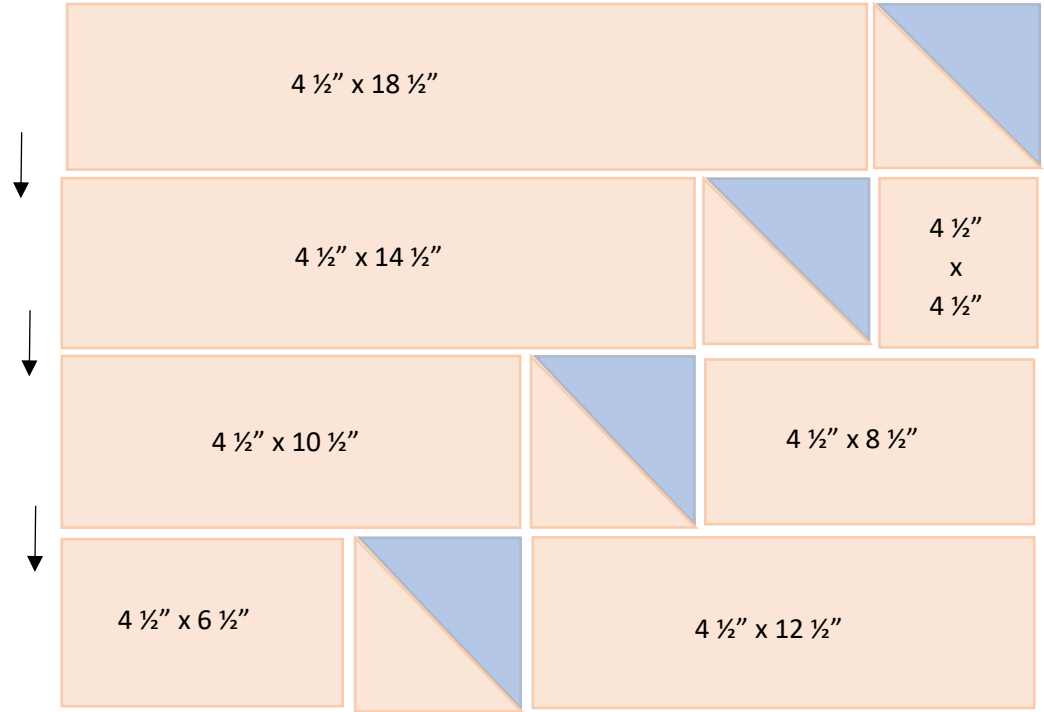
Use care to keep half-square triangle units pointing in the right direction.

Press seams in each row away from the half square triangles.

Unit should measure 22 ½" x 16 ½"

Sew a corner unit to a Wild Turkey Chase Variation block as shown below. Press seams toward the corner units.
