



My Quilting Beehive's 2020 Marvelous Mystery Quilt Month 9



We will be putting together a set of 12 blocks this month! You will need:

- The 12 sampler blocks you have made over all the months.
- The large flying geese & square units made in month 7.
- The remaining $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ flying geese units cut in month 6.

Each sampler block will be the center of a Saw Tooth Star Block. You may choose to make the stars scrappy with different flying geese on each side, or use flying geese made with the same fabric to make a star. Use the techniques we have used over the past 8 months to pin to match your points. Depending on the sampler block, you may have a few points to watch.

First sew a flying geese unit to opposite sides of the sampler block.

Sew with the wrong side of the flying geese unit on top so you can watch your point (see tip in Month 4)

Press seams toward the sampler block.

Then sew the flying geese & square units to the top and bottom. **Press seams as indicated by arrows.**

Blocks should measure $12\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$
