

Mini Mystery Baby Quilt Part 1 of 4 September 2016

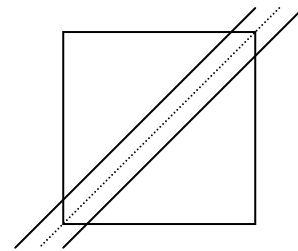
Cutting Instructions:

- Cut five 4 1/2 inch squares from five different scraps
- Cut four 5 1/4 inch squares each from four different scraps
- Cut eighteen 4 1/2 inch squares each from your background fabric (You can make 18 squares with 2 strips from 42" wide fabric)
- Cut four 5 1/4 inch squares each from your background fabric (Cut a 5 1/4 inch strip from your 42 inch wide fabric, we will need more squares of this size another month so set aside extra).

Sewing Instructions

Use the four 5 1/4 inch squares of background and four 5 1/4 inch squares of scraps to make half square triangles. Draw diagonal lines 1/4 inch on each side of the center diagonal of your background fabric. Place one scrap and one background square right sides together. Sew on the lines you marked (1/4 inch from the center). Cut between your stitching along the center. Press seams, and then trim to 4 1/2 inches. You will make 8 half square triangles. Use the four different ones this month. Save the repeats for next month.

Sew on solid lines
Cut on dotted line



Layout for September

B	B	B	<p>All squares are cut to 4 1/2 and will finish at 4 inches B = 4 1/2 inch square of Background fabric S = 4 1/2 inch square of assorted scraps B/S = half square triangles, watch lines for proper positioning</p> <p>Assemble each column (9 squares top to bottom), then sew columns together.</p> <p>Press seams as indicated in bottom row of chart to insure seams will be opposite directions when we are ready for the final assembly.</p>
